How we use cookies

- understand website traffic and usage patterns
- improve website content, usability, and performance

Types of cookies we may use

Strictly necessary cookies

These cookies are required for the website to function properly. They may support core site features such as page navigation, security, accessibility settings, and form submission.

Analytics and performance cookies

These cookies help us understand how visitors use the website, such as which pages are visited most often and how users move through the site. This helps us improve the website over time.

Functional cookies

These cookies help remember preferences and settings to improve your experience on the site.

Optional third-party cookies

If used, these may support embedded videos, maps, scheduling tools, CRM forms, or analytics provided by third-party platforms.

Your choices
